**WHO:** Everyone! If you know 2 steps of a dance (every student now knows at least 2 reel steps), you should come and try your steps out :-)

**Two Groups**, with sub-groups broken down by age, depending on participation:

1. New Beginners  
(Began Irish Dance AFTER Jul 2018)
2. Beginners  
(Began Irish dance lessons AFTER Nov 2017)
3. Advanced Beginners (everyone else)

**HOW MUCH: \$2.50 per dance.**

The following dances are available: reel, light jig, single jig, slip jig, treble jig, hornpipe, traditional set, and treble reel.

Every one of our students knows at east the reel. Many have learned enough light jig as well. If you have questions, call or send me an email.

**MEDALS AND TROPHIES:** Medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> in each dance for each group. Ribbons for 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>. Trophies for the soft shoe champ, hard shoe champ (must compete in all hard- or soft-shoe dances to qualify), and the original choreography challenge.

Ladies: If you have a school performance dress (what we wore for State Fair), wear that with EITHER black tights OR white socks.

Ladies w/o a school dress:  
Wear a black skirt and a black shirt with EITHER black tights OR white socks (with socks, must wear trunks under the skirt.)

Men: Wear black pants and a black shirt with black socks.

**Shoes** – You must wear either Irish Dance shoes or black soft-soled jazz shoes.
